Rudder Box	Metal pin to attach rudder box to gudgeons or			
Fixed Rudder	Metal pin to attach fixed rudder to gudgeons			
Centreboard	When sailing, attached to the boat by a lanyard so that it cannot leave the boat.			
Rudder Blade	If using a Rudder Box and Rudder Blade, the Rudder must be attached to the boat by a lanyard so that it cannot leave the boat.			
2up Sticker	2 Up Sabot to have applied a "2" 50mm x 8mm on the transom 1 Up Sabot to NOT have applied a "2" on the transom
